Sub: Provisional admission to M.A. (Day) courses, session: 2024 - 2025

All internal students of B.A. (Honours) courses completed the sixth and final semester examination in 2024 are advised to note the following.

An internal student (completed the sixth and final semester examination this year) shall be admitted provisionally if s/he passed all papers of B.A.(Hons.) and submits the online application form within the stipulated dates as announced below.

- Students who have completed the B.A. (Honours) Sixth Semester Examination, 2024 may apply online for provisional admission to M.A. (Day) courses (**session 2024 25**) in their respective departments.
- Online application forms will be in the link https://admission.jdvu.ac.in on and from August 1 to August 12, 2024.
- ▶ After online application, they are required to produce the print-out of online application form along with self-attested photocopies of all mark-sheets, certificates including SC/ST/PD/OBC-A/OBC-B certificates, if applicable, income certificate at the time of verification/ admission.
- Anti Ragging Undertaking by student and his/her Parent/ Guardian (CLICK HERE) to be produced at the time of verification/ admission.
- All admissions are provisional.
- As per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD(R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and 1465-BCW/MR-67/10 dt.30/04/2010 from the Government of West Bengal, Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal, unless they can produce a domicile certificate of 10-year residency in West Bengal issued by competent authority.
- Persons with 40% or more disability will only be considered for admission under PD category under RPD Act, 2016.
- The candidates who will be provisionally selected under the OBC- A and OBC- B categories must produce an OBC certificate (the date of issue of the certificate should not be earlier than July 2023) issued by the competent authority that clearly indicates (i) the category (A or B) they belong to; (ii) that they do not belong to creamy layer of the society, at the time of verification/ admission. [The list of competent authority]
- OBC-A and OBC-B candidates of the states other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in educational institutions in West Bengal, unless they can produce a domicile certificate of 10-year residency in West Bengal issued by competent authority. [The list of competent authority]
- Candidates admitted under OBC A/B categories must submit a Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate. The certificate should not be issued earlier than one year from the date of advertisement.
- Candidates admitted under OBC A/B categories must submit an undertaking on a Rs.10/- non-judicial Stamp paper, stating that their admission will be revoked if their OBC certificate becomes invalid in future. (Click here)
- ➤ It is being brought to the notice of all concerned that Ragging is not only a social evil but also a penal offence. Any student/s indulging in ragging of any student/s including freshers during admission / interview and / or subsequently at the hostel or in the class or in the corridors or anywhere inside and outside of the campus, shall be severely dealt with on pain of punishment ranging from loss of academic year / loss of hostel boardership

to expulsion from the university itself. Reporting to the Police Station may also be made in addition to the above punishment.
